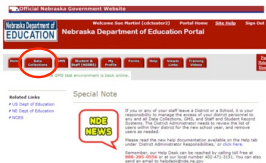
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
Accessing the Report of Suspensions/Expulsions

- Click on the "Consolidated Data Collection (CDC)"





Scenario 2

- Jack, in 9th grade, and Bobby, in 10th grade, each bring one handgun to school. During lunch, Jack and Bobby begin firing at each other simultaneously. No one is hurt. Jack and Bobby are expelled from school for one year and no educational services are provided to them. Neither Jack nor Bobby are children with disabilities under IDEA.
