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Where are the Title I Reports?

- NSSRS (Nebraska Staff and Student Record System)
 - Staff: Staff Templates
 - Student: Student Templates
 - Student: Title I Programs Template
 - Includes some data previously collected in Title I, Part A Annual Participation Report
- CDC (Consolidated Data Collection)
 - Title I, Part A: Annual Participation Report
 - Includes some data previously collected in Title I, Part A Annual Participation Report

How Do I Know if We Have Targeted Assistance Schools or Schoolwide Projects?

- TAS use a matrix to identify students to receive Title I supplemental services
 - Annual self-review
- SW projects have a completed schoolwide plan which has been peer reviewed
 - 40% or higher poverty
 - 3-year peer review schedule
 - Annual self-review

Title I Staff Reporting

Staff in Targeted Assistance Schools

- Use the assignment codes that start with 2
- Teachers report subject area 25 (Title I)

Staff in School-wide projects

- Do not use assignment codes that start with 2
- Teacher report subject area for the appropriate subject or 29 for Supplemental Curriculum

Reporting Instructional Paraprofessionals

Title I Targeted Assistance Schools

- Report only **instructional** paraprofessionals funded by Title I

Title I School-wide Projects

- Report all **instructional** paraprofessionals

See Appendix D of the Staff Template Instructions.

Staff Template: Paraprofessional Assessment Passed Flag

- Title I **Instructional** Paras only
 - Enter “0”
 - If NO assessment was taken
 - If a passing score was not achieved
 - If this person is NOT an instructional paraprofessional
 - When reported by a nonpublic system
 - Enter “1”
 - If a passing score was attained on the ParaPro by ETS

Staff Template: Paraprofessional Assessment Passed Flag (cont.)

- Title I Instructional Paras only
 - Enter “2”
 - If a passing score has been earned on the WorkKeys by ACT
 - Enter “3”
 - If Para Educator by Master Teacher has been passed
 - Enter “4”
 - If a passing score was earned on Project Para by UNL

Reporting Instructional Paraprofessionals

Staff Template:

If no contract:

- Date of contract – leave blank
- Number of Days Contracted – enter zero
- Contract enter 2 (No)
- Contracting Organization – leave blank
- Salary fields – enter zero
- Total Experience and Experience This District can be zero.

Reporting Instructional Paraprofessionals

Staff Assignment Template

- Assignment Code
 - 0-5160 Instructional Paraprofessional
 - W-5160 Instructional Paraprofessional – Title I Schoolwide
- Subject Area = 00
- Grade Taught Code = 00

Student Template: Title I Services to Nonpublic Students

Nonpublic Targeted Assistance [Student:Targeted Assistance (44)]

– ALWAYS considered Targeted Assistance

- Code 1 (Yes) to identify a nonpublic student reported by a public district as receiving Title I services from the public district.
- Code 2 (No) for:
 - public schools students (even if served by Title I)
 - students attending nonpublic and state operated schools.

Title I Programs Template in NSSRS

- Includes some items previously collected in NDE 04-0001: Title I Annual Participation Report
- Student Level Data
 - Services in Targeted Assistance School
 - Title I Services provided to nonpublic students
 - Title I funded Early Childhood services that are NOT part of a schoolwide project

What is Reported in the Title I Programs Template?

- (1) County District Number
- (2) School Year Date: 2009-06-30
- (3) NDE Student ID
 - This is a key field. A value must be supplied for each record or the data loading process will reject the record.
- (4) Reporting Date
 - A value must be supplied for each record or the data loading process will reject the record.

Title I Programs Template

Enter the code indicating if this student received or is receiving the Title I services listed at any time during this school year.

- (5) Title I Reading ELA (English Language Arts)
- (6) Title I Math
- (7) Title I Science
- (8) Title I Social Studies
- (12) Title I Counseling Social work

Title I Programs Template

Enter the code indicating if this student received or is receiving the Title I services listed at any time during this school year.

- (13) Title I Health Dental
- (20) Title I Early Childhood Education
 - Enter the code indicating if this student received or is receiving Title I Early Childhood (pre-kindergarten) services at any time during this school year in a program that is **not** part of a Title I Schoolwide project.

Title I Programs Template

Enter the code indicating if this student received or is receiving the Title I services listed at any time during this school year.

- (21) Title I Vocational/Career
- (22) Title I Support Other
 - You can describe the services received under Support Other in Title I Support Other Description.
- (24) Title I Support Other Desc
 - Provide a description of the other support services this student received or is receiving under Title I Support Other.

What will be reported in the CDC (Consolidated Data Collection)?

- Part 1: TAS and/or SW Special Program Project Sites
 - Family Literacy Services (Yes / No)
 - Extended time Instructional Programs (Yes / No)
 - Schoolwide Projects Serving Students Eligible for the Migrant Education Program
 - Number of SW projects that serve migrant students
 - Number of SW projects that combine migrant education funds

What will be reported in the CDC?

- Part 2: Title I Part A Funded Staff during regular school year in
 - TAS Title I program
 - TAS preschools
 - Title I teachers providing services in nonpublic school
 - Staff in Neglected or Delinquent facilities being paid with Title I, Part A funds

What will be reported in the CDC?

- Part 2: FTE of Title I Part A Funded Staff during regular school year for programs listed on previous slide
 - Administrators (Non-Clerical)
 - This does **NOT** include superintendents
 - Teachers
 - Teacher Aides / Paraprofessionals
 - Staff providing support services (non-clerical)
 - Other (Specify)

What will be reported in the CDC?

- Part 3: Neglected / Delinquent
 - Local Neglected
 - Number of students by grade level, in residential agencies located within the district that received at least 5 days of Title I, Part A funded instruction either in the district or in the Rule 18 interim program school (local neglected only)

What will be reported in the CDC?

- Part 3: Neglected / Delinquent
 - Local Delinquent
 - Include the number of students receiving instructional services
 - Reading / Language Arts
 - Mathematics
 - Science
 - Social Studies
 - Vocational / Career
 - Other (Specify)

What will be reported in the CDC?

- Part 3: Neglected / Delinquent
 - Local Delinquent
 - Include the number of students receiving instructional services
 - Support Services
 - » Guidance / Counseling
 - » Health/Dental/Eye Care
 - » Other (Specify)

What will be reported in the CDC?

- Part 4: HOMELESS—Unaccompanied
 - The term unaccompanied youth includes a youth not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian
 - Living in runaway shelters, abandoned buildings, cars, on the streets, or in other inadequate housing, and children and youth denied housing by their families
